Mr. Lo is the first batch Accredited Safety Auditor and actively participates in OSH such as independent safety auditor, gave lecture in Industrial Centre of Hong Kong Polytechnic University and China University of Geosciences (Wuhan), acted as safety expert in court hearings on numerous occasions, services in professional safety associations, etc.



Abstract

We would discuss if there's room for the safety control mechanism of Korea to be applied in Hong Kong Infrastructure projects by referring to the “Benchmarking Study in Infrastructure Projects in Korea” by OSHC.
