#### **INTRODUCTION**

## ABOUT CPD PROGRAMME 1

CPD Programme 1 will focus on high court cases in OSH, aiming to enhance the knowledge of RSO in OSH legislation. The Programme consists of a series of workshops, and each 6-hour workshop will examine 5 or 6 high court cases. It will introduce to the participants the judgments arrived at by the courts in Hong Kong in respect of OSH regulations and the impact these cases may have in our day-to-day business activities. By the end of the workshop, participants should:

- 1. Be aware of the courts' word on OSH legislation;
- 2. Learn the digest of legal authorities through case law;
- 3. Learn more about rule of laws applicable to OSH.

- HKSAR vs Shun Tak Properties Limited (2009)
  - This is a case related to cleaning building external walls and windows using gondolas.
- HKSAR vs China Overseas Building and Engineering Co., Ltd (2005)
  - This is a case related to fall of person from height when working on a construction site.
- The Attorney General vs Cheung Kee Fung Cheung Construction Co., Ltd (1989)
   This is a case related to whether a man who was fatally injured in an accident on a construction site was a "workman" within the meaning of the Construction Sites (Safety) Regulations.

## HIGH COURT CASES STUDY (1:30 PM - 4:30 PM):

- HKSAR vs Chun Wo Building Construction Limited (2000)
  - This is a case related to a worker working on conduit boxes at the second floor of the construction site resulting in
- HKSAR vs Chun Fai Construction Co., Ltd ((2005)
  - This is a case related to a worker falling from the first floor level to the ground while engaging in concreting work.
- HKSAR vs Hip Hing Construction Co., Ltd. (2004)
  - This is a case related to a worker being struck by falling object when working on a construction site

## **EXERCISE:**

During the workshop, participants are encouraged to enter into discussion about the judgment of the cases. What lessons can we learn from these judgments? What precautions would we take in the light of these decisions? What impact of these decisions would have on our day-to-day business activities or operations?
