Abstract:

Gondolas are widely used in the construction industry. It is used to carry persons for working at height to perform construction works such as façade and curtain wall installation, piping fixture, external wall and window cleaning. In recent years, there were still some incidents occurred relating to the use of gondola. This seminar is a lesson learnt from these incidents occurred in Hong Kong and Macau, and introduce the safety standards applied on gondola for reference.


