Objectives

This subject will introduce students to the discipline of ergonomics - the scientific discipline concerned with the understanding of interaction among humans and other elements of a system; and the design and evaluation of tasks, jobs, products, environments and system in order to make them compatible with the needs, abilities and limitations of people. This course meets the learning objectives for the British Occupational Hygiene Society Syllabus W506/M203 Ergonomics Essentials.

Assessment

Optional Assessment -online until 15th January 2016, and final exam at UOW early February 2016.

International/remote students may be able to sit the exam externally. A suitable invigilator and venue must be nominated by the student and approved by UOW. An additional \$100 administration fee applies for this option.

Course Description

By the end of this course, participants will be able to identify, describe and implement ergonomics principles to promote safety, productivity and health. They will also be able to describe the three domains of ergonomics as well as identify and apply a selection of appropriate ergonomics risk assessment tool/s for a workplace issues and prepare recommendations for ergonomics risk control.

Assessment

- The assessment for this course will involve: 1. An on line guiz
- 2. A report in the form of an ergonomics risk assessment

3. An exam at the UOW at the beginning of February

Blended Delivery Methods

Attendance on campus will be from **23rd – 27th November 2015** with online material available from 16th November until 15 January 2016.

Should the participant elect to be assessed, online access and assessment tasks run until 15th January 2016.
