Keynote Speaker:



Dr. Glenn S. Pransky has directed the Center for Disability Research at the Liberty Mutual Research Institute for Safety since 1999. His research group conducts scientific investigations on disability prevention and prognosis of work-related musculoskeletal disorders, work disability in older workers, methods to achieve safe and sustained return to work, and preventing work disability. He is an associate professor in the Department of Family Medicine and Community Health at the University of Massachusetts Medical School and a Visiting Lecturer at the Harvard School of Public Health and the University of Massachusetts/Lowell. Prior to joining Liberty Mutual, he directed the Occupational and Environmental Health Program at the University of Massachusetts, overseeing research activities and training in occupational health. In 1995, he was a Visiting Scholar at the Agency for Health Care Policy and Research, Washington, DC, focusing on health services research. He has produced more than 120 peer-reviewed scientific publications and book chapters, and frequently presents at international scientific conferences.

Dr. Pransky received his M.D. from Tufts School of Medicine, and a MS in occupational health from the Harvard School of Public Health, and is board-certified in occupational medicine and internal medicine. He is an active member of the American College of Occupational and Environmental Medicine, the National Academy of Social Insurance, and is Chairman of the Work Disability Prevention Scientific Committee of the International Commission on Occupational Health. He received the NIOSH Innovative Research Award in 2008, the American College of Occupational Medicine's Keogh Award for Academic Excellence in 2009, and Royal Society of Medicine's Osler Medal in 2011. He is a senior editor for the Journal of Occupational Rehabilitation.
